




Visiting Bucharest – the capital of Romania


Despite the short time we spend in Bucharest we managed to see a lot – Museum of Senses, The Parliament or simply the vintage streets of the capital.







The Palace of Parliament- Palatul Parlamentului

On the last day of our trip we went through Bucharest to Palace of Parliament which was the biggest parliament building in Europe and second on the whole world. It was built by Nicolae Ceausescu – a Romanian dictator. It scores a third place with its volume. The height of the parliament is 84 meters, and the floor area reaches 365 000 square meters. The entire building was a result of over 100 000 workers. Total area which was demolished represented an equivalent of the fifth part of the Bucharest area. Over 57 000 families were evicted because of this building.



Palace of Parliament had been built for twelve years. The building used up 3 500 tones of crystal for 480 chandeliers, 200 000 square meters of woolen carpets, 700 000 tones of steel and bronze, 900 000 cubic meters of wood.
